

William “Rayburn” Ashabranner of Liberty Hill, Texas passed away Thursday, February 18, 2021 with his wife at his side. He is preceded in death by his parents Rayburn T. and Wilma Phillips Ashabranner.

Rayburn graduated from Burnet High School and went into the Army Reserve. He worked for a contractor and eventually had an opportunity to go to work for the Texas Highway Dept. He worked for the Texas Dept. of Transportation for over 43 years. He loved his job and enjoyed the contractors he met. He was one of the founding members of the Burnet Gun Club which began in the 1960s. At the time of his death he was an honorary member and was proud of the organization it had become.
